The Maeght Foundation is a spectacular vision of modernist ideas, completely dedicated to creating a space that is welcoming the arts and visitors of this century. Everything is worth a look if not two; the complex created by architect Josep Lluís Sert who also created the vast studio of Joan Miró; the sculpture garden upon entering; one of the largest collections of paintings, sculptures and graphic works in Europe with works by Balthus, Bonnard, Braque, Calder, Chagall, Chillida, Giacometti, Léger, Miró, Ubac, Tal-Coa and contemporary artists.

Currently on show is Rites de passage by the artist A.R. Penck.

FRANCIS BACON MB ART FOUNDATION

This private collection now includes more than 2,500 items dedicated to Francis Bacon. At the heart of the MB Art Collection is a selection of Bacon's paintings from the late 1920s to the early 1980s, along with work by peers and other key influences. It was founded by the Monegasque Majid Boustany, who had been contemplating contemplating Bacon's attachment to and fascination with the Riviera for twenty years before finally inaugurating the project in 2014.

The Foundation holds two of the few design objects Bacon designed influenced by contemporaries such as Eileen Gray.
